#### Objektbeschrijving:

Situated in the heart of Palma's old town in one of the city's most popular shopping streets, this stylishly-renovated apartment is located between small boutique shops and numerous restaurants and cafés.

Its total constructed living area of 267 sqm features 4 large double bedrooms, 4 bathrooms, 2 of which are en suite, an openly-designed living/dining area with an impressive American kitchen, and an additional hobby room.

The lovely apartment combines a charming mix of traditional styles and modern loft character with its Mallorcan tiled floors, high ceilings with classic exposed ceiling beams, and original windows.

Further highlights are the 15 sqm terrace which is accessible from both the living area and one of the bedrooms, and the additional 22 sqm private roof terrace, both providing the perfect retreat after a long day or the ideal place to spend relaxing hours enjoying the Mallorcan sun.

Further features include hot/cold air conditioning, a fully-equipped fitted kitchen with Miele appliances, fitted wardrobes, bathrooms with Mortex-finish and stone washbasins.
